As in past years, I write with a special invitation for you to participate in a very important project here at Pope John Paul II High School, our annual Continuous Improvement Survey.

The data we gather from the survey helps us understand what we are doing well as a school and also what opportunities we have to make us even better. Survey questions center on five key areas, Instructional Quality, Constituent Relations, Operational Excellence, Finance and Overall Satisfaction. We estimate it should take 10-15 minutes to complete. You will have the chance to rate each area on a five point scale and also add comments where necessary.

Here are some other details

- The survey will be open from now, until March 31, 2025.
- Since parents from each Archdiocesan high school will be completing the survey, we
 ask that if you have students at a high school you complete the survey at each
 school.
- · All information gathered is secure (you don't have to provide your name).
- · For data accuracy, we ask each family to complete the survey once.
- We will receive the survey results in April and will communicate them to you soon after. Know that all data gathered benefits us here at Pope John Paul II High School.
- The survey results will provide us with needed data that helps us maintain a school culture focused on continuous improvement.

SENIORS - College Acceptance and Scholarship & Grant Awards Please Submit to the Guidance Office

As the first semester comes to a close, some colleges may request your midyear grades. Most colleges do not require midyear grades, so they are only sent if requested. If requested, an updated academic report, which will include your first and second marking period grades, as well as first semester grades, will be sent to the colleges you indicate. Please complete the Midyear Grade Request Form (below) if your college(s) are requiring midyear grades.

If your college does not request your midyear grades but you would like to submit them, then please check your portal first to see if grades can be uploaded (this is the quickest, most efficient way). If you cannot upload senior grades to your portal, then please complete the Midyear Grade Request Form (below). If you self-reported your initial transcript (ex. SRAR), then you need to self-report your midyear grades, as well. Please let Mrs. Bell know if you need an updated copy of your transcript for reference.

Midyear transcript requests will be processed beginning the week of February 3rd, which is when the second quarter grades, first semester grades, GPA and rank will be finalized and validated. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to reach out to Mrs. Bell at dbell@pjphs.org.
