Principal's Office

Beginning Monday, March 31st, the start of the 4th quarter, students may begin to wear the spring uniform.

- - All students may choose to wear an official Pope John Paul II High School polo in place of the blouse or shirt, tie, and sweater. Any shirt placed under the polo must be white, tucked, and not protrude from the bottom of the polo or past the ends of the sleeves. If you are cold, please wear a long sleeve polo, school sweater, or winter uniform. Sweatshirts or PJP sports attire are not permitted.
- - Ladies have the option to wear navy blue opaque<u>Flynn and O'Hara</u> knee socks pulled to the knee in place of their tights.
- - Skirts may not be rolled or altered in any way. Skort length should be no shorter than one inch above the knee.

The spring uniform is optional, you may continue to wear the winter uniform if you wish, especially on cooler spring days.

Thank you for your attention to these details. Please remind students that the PJP uniform is a source of pride in their school and should be worn accordingly.

It's tax season, and many are preparing to finalize their returns for the 2024 tax year. If you participated in the *EITC (Educational Improvement Tax Credit) program*, you know you are receiving a 90% tax credit back. If you have not participated yet, we ask you to take a look at your PA state tax return on line 12. What is your tax liability? Is your liability over \$1,000? Then you can maximize the impact of your tax dollars and choose where they go by directing them to PJP for scholarships for students and families that qualify.

For example, a donation of \$10,000 to PJP via the EITC tax credit program will give you a credit of \$9,000 back. Your net out-of-pocket is <u>only</u>\$1,000.

Currently, 255 qualifying students and their families benefit from the money raised through the EITC program. That's 30% of our student body! It's easy to participate.


