Privacy Policy

Collection of Personal Information

We only collect personal information when voluntarily provided by users, such as through emails, surveys, or online forms. Any personal information shared with us is used solely for the specified purpose at the time of collection and is not shared with non-affiliated third parties unless explicitly stated during the information collection process.

Consent for Use of Information

When consent is necessary for using or disclosing personal information, we will seek permission from the appropriate party. For student-related information, consent will be obtained from the student and/or parent, in line with our policies, and considering the student's maturity and understanding of the implications of the information's use and disclosure.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files stored in your browser to help retain preferences, such as calendar settings and bookmarks, or to maintain login status when visiting protected areas of the site. Cookies on our site are not linked to any personally identifiable information. Browsers offer settings to accept, reject, or delete cookies, but note that certain site functionalities may be limited if cookies are disabled.

Log Files

As with many standard websites, we use web statistics tools, like Google Analytics, to analyze trends in site usage. Collected data includes IP addresses, visitor locations (country, city), browser types, ISPs, referring and exit pages, platform type, timestamps, time spent on each page, and keywords used in search engines to locate our site. This information is anonymous and is used to improve website design and functionality, as well as to enhance user experience.

Our website may contain links to other websites. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of external sites and recommend reviewing their privacy policies when visiting. This privacy policy only applies to data collected by our website.

Security Measures

We prioritize the security of personal information. Data provided by users, such as contact or payment details, is protected with advanced SSL encryption upon submission. All servers storing personally identifiable information are kept in secure environments, and credit card information is never stored on our website servers.
