Academic Affairs



PSAT Testing will be taking place this week. These tests are a significant part of your child's academic journey. All 9th grade students will take the PSAT 8/9 and all 10th and 11th grade students will take the PSAT. This test also serves as the National Merit Scholarship Corporation's Qualifying for those students who are juniors. These tests are taken electronically on the students' chromebooks so please be sure that your child reports to school with their chromebook fully charged and brings their charger with them as well. We have extremely limited loaner devices and cords, so it is very important that each student brings their devices with them. There is a <u>Desmos</u> calculator built into the testing platform so while your student is welcome to bring their own approved calculator with them, if they do not have one, an approved calculator is available within the test. The <u>College Board Calculator Policy</u> is available online.

PJP reviews results across all grades when determining a student's eligibility for enrollment in AP classes and when making decisions about a student's course level during the course selection process in the spring.

Students will take the exam in their Homeroom. The classroom used by the Music Homeroom is not set up for test taking. If your child is in the Music Homeroom, they will report to the following rooms:

9th Grade: Room 145 with Deacon Hoyer 10th and 11th Grades: Room 23 with Mr. Lynn

Dismissal is expected by 11:30 a.m. Please be sure you check with your local school district to confirm whether or not they will be providing transportation home from school. Those students who are staying to attend Grandparents day will need transportation home when the event is over.

Blood Drive


The NHS is hosting a Red Cross Blood Drive on Wednesday, November 13. Parents, please take a look at the requirements for student donors.

Stadium Perimeter Policies

As we start to host night athletic events outside we are instituting some new policies to help keep our PJP spectators and visiting spectators safe.

- All PJP spectators should enter the perimeter at the check in site closest to the school building.
- No outside food or drinks will be allowed past the check in area.
- No bags larger than a belt bag will be allowed past the check in table.
- All students must show their student IDs to enter the perimeter.
- Any student 8th grade or younger will not be admitted without a parent or guardian in attendance.
- Any student suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be required to be tested. Students refusing to be tested will be disciplined according to the procedures listed in the handbook in our Substance Abuse Policy.

COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID FORMS-FAFSA & CSS Profile

FAFSA - Opens December 1st

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is the application used to apply for federal student aid, such as federal grants, work-study, and loans. In addition, many states and colleges use your FAFSA information to determine your eligibility for state and school aid, and some private financial aid providers may use your FAFSA information to determine whether you qualify for their aid.

Senior students and parents can create their Studentaid.gov Account (FSA ID) now. This is recommended to be done prior to the release of the 2025-26 FAFSA application on December 1st, 2024. So, create your *StudentAid.gov* account now to be FAFSA® form ready!

CSS Profile - Open Now

In addition to the FAFSA, there are about 400 colleges and universities that require the completion of an additional financial aid form called the CSS Profile. The CSS Profile is used for consideration of any institutional aid that the college may be able to offer your student. *Be sure the college requires the CSS profile prior to registration*. Again, like the FAFSA, the CSS Profile has a variety of deadlines to consider. Your exact deadline depends on the specific college you're applying to, so check the colleges' websites.
